

WHAT THE ACCREDITATION IS

Erasmus+ accreditation for adult education (often called the Erasmus Plan / KA120 accreditation) is awarded to an organisation that demonstrates it has a structured plan (the Erasmus Plan) and capacity to run high-quality transnational learning mobility for staff and adult learners. Once accredited you may apply in the special accredited strand (KA121 for accredited projects) instead of one-off short projects.

Educational programmes

Courses, trainings, retreats, other non-formal education activities for social workers, social educators, and volunteers from across the country

Community centres

Delivering social care, day-centre services and community support while also acting as a hub for non-formal education


FIRST-YEAR PLAN SUBMITTED: MID FEB 2025.

Budget for Year 1: €56,000 (to spend by 31 Aug 2026).




Total amount for Year 1 was decided centrally and communicated late — so you must be ready to update plans once you know your allocation.

WE STARTED CAUTIOUSLY: NO EXTERNAL PROVIDER COURSES OR DAY-CENTRE CLIENT MOBILITIES IN YEAR 1 TO AVOID INCLUSION/ORGANISATION RISKS.

INSTEAD WE PLANNED THREE PARTNER-BASED MOBILITIES (10–12 PARTICIPANTS EACH):

Staff job-shadowing to Poland (staff to learn to organise adult education). Staff job-shadowing to Lithuania (day-centre staff at partner addiction centre). Learners to Germany (learning/job-shadowing for volunteers and professionals).

Once familiar with the systems, submitting projects is straightforward; National Agency communication was good and payments arrived quickly.

















KA2 - Cooperation among organisations and institutions -Partnerships for Cooperation

As one of the project partners, we were involved in developing a qualification and certification scheme for Domestic Violence Response Coordinators:

- developing a qualification profile,
- a core curriculum,
- piloting a blended learning course,
- creating a certification scheme at EQF Level 5,
- setting up an e-platform with learning resources and a virtual network.


ESC SOLIDARITY PROJECTS
